## **General Information:**

- A maximum of 2 tests per horse, can be over 2 consecutive levels.
- Attire and Gear: Informal but appropriate, coloured shirt, jodhpurs and saddle pads allowed, plaiting is not required, but equipment is by EA Dressage Rules. This means no boots or bandages on your horses. If you use illegal equipment & the judges notices it you may still be eliminated. Even though it is a video competition EA rules apply.
- Riders must be a current financial member of Park Ridge Active Riding Group.

## Video tips:

- 1. have the person videoing stand 3-5m from "C" in a straight line with "A". This is the normal judging position your tests are judged from.
- 2. use a tripod to hold the videoing device to prevent hand shake or dropping of device
- 3. have the device holder zoom in a little when horse & rider are in the far half of the arena. Zoom out when they are close to the device. Do not zoom in entirely on horse & rider but have horse & rider in centre of screen shot. Try to give the judge the best view of the horse & rider throughout the test.
- 4. turn the sound down so any wind noise is minimised or talking from supporters & viewers can't be heard on the video.
- 5. ensure the light on the arena is consistent. Inconsistent lighting & interfere with the video causing it to adjust itself which doesn't help the flow of the video.
- 6. These tips are to help you make the most of your video. A judge can only judge what she can see so your video needs to be clear & still.
